The Manager of Finance – Seminars is a leadership role in the Lockheed Martin Leadership Association reporting to the Senior Manager of Finance and to the Director of Finance. The Manager of Finance main role is to work collaboratively with the LMLA Office Manager, Conference Room POCs, and Edward Jones to organize financial seminars at the Main Plant and the Beach St locations throughout the year. Due to COVID-19, this position will require skills to manage events virtually through Zoom meetings as well as in person once things return to normal. Also to note is that this position touches every aspect of the LMLA organization – the Manager of Finance should be comfortable meeting with the Executive Leadership Team and their Directorates for event planning, payment request/authorization, and budgetary support. With success, the responsibilities will expand:

Phase 1: Lead Financial Seminars – minimum of four per year.

Phase 2: Take over support of Venmo & PayPal payments for every LMLA Event. This includes payment acceptance and refunds and working with respective event manager and office manager on transactions.

Phase 3: Learn the payment request process to document and approve (sign) payment requests.

Phase 4: Observe and learn the monthly reporting process which includes Quick Books, Chase Business Checking, Edward Jones financials, and budgets. The long-term goal is to get everyone trained and proficient on monthly reporting.

Manager of Finance is responsible for:

- Responsible for LMLA banking and funds management, including check requests, account reconciliation, and banking deposits
- Quality communication and maintain relationship with Financial Partner Edward Jones
- Find additional financial seminar providers if deemed necessary
- Taking payments/deposits when deemed necessary via PayPal or Venmo
